




He says take photos first and save all your receipts.

Also it doesn't matter if the tree is yours or a neigbhor's.

"The tree itself is not an insurance claim. The wind storm is what the covered insurance claim is," said Guercio. "The wind storm cause the tree to come down, whether it's your neighbor's tree, the village's tree, a tree on the sidewalk."

Guercio says most policies will cover the cost of a hotel room if you can't stay at home.


